³¹ "Behold, the days are coming, declares the LORD, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and the house of Judah, ³² not like the covenant that I made with their fathers on the day when I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt, my covenant that they broke, though I was their husband, declares the LORD. ³³ For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, declares the LORD: I will put my law within them, and I will write it on their hearts. And I will be their God, and they shall be my people. ³⁴ And no longer shall each one teach his neighbor and each his brother, saying, 'Know the LORD,' for they shall all know me, from the least of them to the greatest, declares the LORD. Rev. Chris Dowdell Walker Guest Preacher



Chris D. Walker is the daughter of Katherine (deceased) and Newstell Dowdell, Jr. She is married to Joseph W. Walker, Jr. Together they raised five children and they have twelve grandchildren.

Chris Dowdell Walker is an ordained elder in the AME Church. She has served as pastor for 27 years. During this time-period she served the following three churches: St. Matthew, Emmanuel and is currently the pastor at St. Paul Eastlake. She worked to combine the St. Matthew and Emmanuel congregations. She has provided leadership in the development of outreach programs on both the local and state levels. In 2015 she conceived, developed and launched the first ever 9th Episcopal District Food Bank. All AME churches in Alabama were encouraged to bring food items that are

then sorted, stocked, bagged and distributed across the State of Alabama to hungry families. In recognition of this work she was awarded the Spirit of Compassion award.

Chris received both a BSW and MSW from the University of Alabama. She started her career at the Jefferson County Department of Human Resources (DHR) and she worked there in various capacities for 21 years. While employed there she became the first African American Program Supervisor and Program Manager in Child Welfare and the first to supervise the development of local resources and the first local accounting unit. She was also a major contributor in writing Jefferson County DHR's implementation plan to address the R.C. Consent Decree.

Chris was hired at UAB in 1999 as the BSW Field Director, making her the first full time African American faculty is Social Work. During her tenure with the Social Work Program she also serves as the BSW program director and led the program through the accreditation process to successfully be reaffirmed in 2008. As field director she has partnered with over 100 agencies that provide internships for BSW students, developed a blended capstone seminar, utilized technology to monitor students' progress in placements and presented innovative field concepts at national conferences.

In May 2017, Chris Walker stepped down as Field Director of the UAB Department of Social Work, a position she has held for 15 years. In her tenure at UAB, she has partnered with agencies across Birmingham in an effort to provide our students with internship opportunities, develop an innovative educational program and mentor thousands of social work students. She has served locally on over 21 boards and committees and offered her expertise as a licensed social worker to young, developing agencies. In recognition of her devotion to the field of social work the **Chris Dowdell Walker Excellence in Field Scholarship** was established in her honor.
